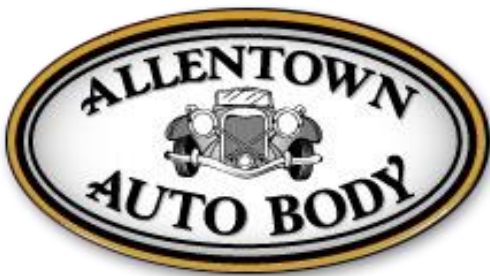




2024 Allentown Lions Craft Beer Garden

BEVERAGE LIST

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IPAs

12. Bent Iron Brewing (Hamilton, NJ)

Odessa IPA 6.8% ABV – 16 oz pour

New England IPA brewed with Pale 2-row packed with Cryo Simcoe, Cryo Citra, and Cryo Amarillo hops

6. Cape May Brewing (Rio Grande, NJ)

Coastal Evacuation 8.0% ABV 12 oz pour

Double IPA with copious amounts of Centennial hops.

7. Evil Genius Beer Company (Philadelphia, PA.)

Stacy's Mom 7.5% ABV 16 oz pour

IPA with low bitterness and lots of hop flavor. It's dry-hopped entirely with Citra.

8. Evil Genius Beer Company (Philadelphia, PA.)

Work Sucks, I Know 5.4% ABV 16 oz pour

The beer features an abundance of tropical, stone-fruit flavors from additions of juicy hops like Galaxy and strong citrus notes from Citra hops.

Firestone Walker Brewing Co. (Paso Robles, CA)

23. Union Jack IPA 7.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

This aggressively hopped West Coast IPA showcases stunning pineapple, citrus and piney aromas along with exceptional dry hop flavors of grapefruit and tangerine. This intense brew finds its balance in honey-like pale malt sweetness.

27. Cali Squeeze Blood Orange IPA 5.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

Brewed with real blood orange for maximum refreshment. A crisp beer with juicy orange flavors and fresh citrus flavors, that always go down easy.

10. Heavy Seas Beer (Halethorpe MD.)

TropiCannon 7.25% ABV 16 oz pour

Citrus IPA is exploding with bright citrus aroma and flavor. Packs a full blast of blood orange, grapefruit, mango and lemon flavor. Amped with citrus with Palisade hops for Amarillo and even more Simcoe. We've introduced dried grapefruit, orange and lemon peel in the brewing process and added mango, blood orange and more grapefruit post-fermentation.

Maine Beer Company (Freeport, ME)

28. Lunch IPA 7.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

Aromas of caramel, orange, papaya, grapefruit, and underlying floral notes, with hints of onion and garlic.

29. Peeper 6.5% ABV- 16 oz pour

Aromas of peach, orange, lemon, grapefruit, and melon. Notes of pine, raspberry, and strawberry. Underlying malt grain sweetness.

30. Wolfe's Neck 6.5% ABV- 16 oz pour

Aromas of pineapple, mango, guava, coconut, and orange. Notes of onion and garlic. Underlying toasted bread and pine.

25. New Trail Brewing Company (Williamsport, PA)

Broken Heels Hazy IPA 7.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

A Hazy IPA hopped intrepidly with hand-selected Citra and Mosaic, leading to High Aromatics of luminous Citrus, rich Conifer, and refreshing Tropicals.

4. Revolution Brewing (Chicago, IL)

Anti Hero 6.7% ABV - 16 oz pour

Anti-Hero combines five classic U.S. hop varieties to marshal an uncompromising hop bomb with bold citrus, floral, and pine aromas. Flavor notes of grapefruit, lemon candy, and orange marmalade set the board for bracing bitterness that provides a reset for the next aromatic sip. #1 selling IPA in Illinois today.

17. Screamin' Hill Brewery (Cream Ridge, NJ)

Thresher IPA 6.8% ABV - 16 oz pour

Our haziest IPA is dry-hopped with Citra and Azacca. Packs punches of tropical fruit flavors.

24. Sloop Brewing Co. (Elizaville, New York)

Juice Bomb Hazy NE IPA 6.5% ABV - 16 oz pour

A blast of tropical aroma is followed by a resinous and balanced flavor. Juice bomb features all the aspects and nuances of full hop flavor — not just bitterness. An IPA for real hop lovers.

26. Victory (Downingtown, PA)

Brotherly Love Hazy IPA 6.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

The aroma starts with bright citrus notes that drift into a tropical fruit character and finishes with a touch of apricot. With this smooth crushable body, always craving one more sip is inevitable.

CIDERS

Downeast Cider House (Boston, MA)

38. Original Blend Cider 5.1% ABV - 16 oz pour

Freshly pressed, unfiltered hard cider meant to taste like freshly pressed apple juice.

39. Blackberry Cider 5.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

Juicy and sweet, tastes and smells just like farm fresh cider you drank as a kid. Intensely flavorful, remarkably drinkable.

40. Pumpkin Cider 5.1% ABV - 16 oz pour

unfiltered blend of apples, pumpkin, and delicious chai spices.

3. Woodchuck Hard Ciders (Middlebury, VT)

Blueberry Cider 5.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

This crisp apple cider is topped off with a splash of blueberry juice to keep you refreshed all season long.

OCTOBER FEST BEERS

34. Goose Island Beer Co. (Chicago, IL.)

Oktoberfest 5.7% ABV - 16 oz pour

Brimming with notes of toasted malt and freshly baked rye bread. This light bodied German lager is clean and crisp with a fine noble hop character and mild earthy bitterness that is the hallmark of Hallertau hops.

15. Screamin' Hill Brewery (Cream Ridge, NJ)

Oktoberfest 5.7% ABV 16 oz pour

This traditional Marzen beer is malty yet balanced, medium-bodied and satisfying.

33. Victory (Downingtown, PA)

Festbier 5.6% ABV - 16 oz pour

Smooth, medium-bodied amber akin to the great Oktoberfest beers of Munich.

TEAS AND SELTZERS

13. Bent Iron Brewing (Hamilton, NJ)

Lemon Lime (h)anxiety 4.5% ABV 16 oz pour

Hard Seltzer with Lime Flavoring

37. Hoop Tea (Baldwinsville, NY)

Spiked Ice Tea 5.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

Our original spiked iced tea is a classic flavor you know and love. Pour it over ice with a freshly squeezed lemon.

PILSNER

35. Double Nickel Beer Company (Freeport, ME)

Pilsner 5.6% ABV- 16 oz pour

A classically styled clean and crisp option for the lite beer drinker and beer geek alike, Our modern take on a traditional German Pilsner.

19. Old Hights Brewing Company (Hightstown, NJ)

Parlor Trick – 4.5 ABV 16 oz pour

Light and clean pilsner with floral and citrus notes

LAGER and PALE ALE

22. Double Nickel Beer Company (Freeport, ME)

Weekend Warrior Hazy Pale Ale 5.8% ABV- 16 oz pour

Double dry hopped with Citra and Idaho7, Weekend Warrior is a refreshing wave of pineapple, apricot, citrus and mango.

9. Narragansett Brewing Company (Narragansett, RI)

Lager – 5.0 ABV 16oz pour

Made on Honor for five generations, The Famous Narragansett Lager has been one of the greats since 1890. Today, the highest rated, heritage American lager (according to Beer Advocate) is brewed to be clean, crisp, refreshing and perfectly balanced. "Hi Neighbor! Have a 'Gansett!"

18. Old Hights Brewing Company (Hightstown, NJ)

1721 Lager – 6.5 ABV 16 oz pour

Our golden lager has a touch of sweetness balanced by a bit of spice from traditional noble hops. Brewed to celebrate the year Hightstown was founded.

16. Screamin' Hill Brewery (Cream Ridge, NJ)

Bullocks 5.3% ABV - 16 oz pour

This Helles style lager showcases our barley grown right here at Bullock Farms. Our straightforward recipe pairs Pilsner malt with traditional German hops. Bullocks Lager drinks incredibly easy with subtle malt sweetness and a soft finish.

Von Trapp Brewing (Stowe, VT.)

32. Golden Helles Lager 5.0% ABV >> 16 oz pour

Traditional in style, Helles is brewed with Pilsner Malt to produce a dry, snappy finish while Perle and Tettnanger hops create a spicy, herbal hop aroma. The result is an incredibly clean, yet complex, lager.

31. Kölsch 5.0% ABV >> 16 oz pour

Kölsch Style Ale famously originated in Cologne, Germany and is fermented with German ale yeast, yet finished with time to lager. Our Kölsch continues this tradition, true to style, crisp, and refreshing. Brewed with natural Vermont spring water, the resulting beer is a perfect balance of German malts, hops, and Vermont craftsmanship

21. Three Floyds Brewing (Munster, IN.)

Zombie Dust Pale Ale 6.5% ABV - 16 oz pour

This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse. Created with our marvelous friends in the comic industry.

PUMPKIN BEERS

11. Bent Iron Brewing (Hamilton, NJ)

Mischief Imperial Pumpkin 8.6% ABV – 12 oz pour

Imperial pumpkin ale brewed with pumpkin puree delivering a superb orange color. A nose and taste of seasonal spice for the fall.

36. Brooklyn Brewery (Lewes, DE)

Post Road Pumpkin Ale 5.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

Blended with barley malt, pumpkins became a commonly used beer ingredient. Post Road Pumpkin Ale brings back this tasty tradition. Hundreds of pounds of pumpkins are blended into the mash of each batch, creating a beer with an orange amber color, warm pumpkin aroma, biscuity malt center, and crisp finish.

1. Dogfish Head Brewery (Lewes, DE)

Pumpkin Ale 7.0% ABV - 16 oz pour

A full-bodied brown ale with smooth hints of pumpkin and brown sugar. We brew our Punkin Ale with pumpkin meat, brown sugar and spices. As the season cools, this is the perfect beer to warm up with

2. Sam Adams (Boston, MA.)

Jack-O' Pumpkin Ale 4.4% ABV – 16oz pour

Jack-O's cinnamon and nutmeg aromas recall memories of freshly baked pumpkin pie. It has the ideal balances of seasonal spices with a crisp, refreshing finish. This pumpkin ale pairs perfectly with the transition of summer into cooler days and nights.

Blueberry Sour 5.5% ABV 16 oz pour
Smoothie Sour loaded with Blueberry.

DARK BEERS

- 5. Forge Dublin Brewery** (Hightstown, NJ)
Irish Stout 4.2% ABV - 16 oz pour
Forged Irish Stout by Conor McGregor. A beautifully hand-crafted stout with hints of chocolate and coffee roasted notes.
- 20. Old Hights Brewing Company** (Hightstown, NJ)
Hand Machines Doppleback 6.8% ABV - 16 oz pour
Originally brewed by monks in Munich, this German-style doppelbock is rich in malty goodness, reminiscent of toasty bread.
